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COST OF ALLERGY SHOTS (AIT)

Allergy shots (Allergen Immunotherapy or AIT) have 3 associated charges. The extract supply CPT Code 95165 (\$44 per unit) is billed annually for a 1- year supply of your allergy extracts and is almost always covered by insurance plans (charge #1 annually). The approximate cost ranges from \$1,500 - \$5,500 for the first year of AIT. The second year of AIT, as the frequency of your injections decreases to once a month, so will your extract cost. Unless you have a large deductible, your insurance company pays us directly for your annual supply of allergy extracts. You may also be responsible for a copay or coinsurance for this charge (charge # 2) annually.

The third charge #3 is the charge for your allergy shot(s) is CPT Code 95115 (single \$40) or 95117 (multiple \$50). Depending on your insurance plan, you will have to pay \$0 - \$50 each time you come in for your allergy shot(s). Some plans require that you pay nothing out of pocket for your allergy shots and a very few plans have no coverage at all.

We encourage you to call your insurance company directly to confirm your coverage prior to initiating AIT. If you have no insurance coverage, please speak to a FCAAIA billing representative about the costs of AIT. Usually, we can work things out with discounts, payment plans, etc.

Allergy shots have been administered for more than 100 years. Numerous studies have shown that allergy shots (AIT) are extremely effective and are tremendously beneficial to patients. If you have any additional questions, please feel free to ask.
